Both owner & exhibitor must be current NSBA members.

Eligibility:

Lead Line

For participants 8 years or younger. All exhibitors are required to wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI approved helmet. All exhibitors shall be assisted by a handler at least 18 years old. Participants will not be placed. All exhibitors will receive a participation prize.

Small Fry

Exhibitors 12 & Under as of January 1st. All exhibitors are required to wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI approved helmet. Walk & Trot only.

Rookie

It is the exhibitor responsibility to prove their eligibility. Both Horse & Exhibitor cannot have earned more than 10 lifetime points in that particular class. Exhibitor does not have to own the registered horse. Exhibitor must be a current member of AQHA.

High Point & Reserve High Point :

Small Fry

Rookie Youth & Rookie Amateur
Novice Youth & Novice Amateur
Youth, Amateur & Select Amateur
Open

Each Team (horse/rider) must show in 3 events. All division but Rookie & Novice must also show in one halter class to be eligible for the High Point awards. Green classes do not count. Special Event classes do not count toward High Point Awards.

Circuit Champion Award: The highest AQHA combined placing (all 4 judges) for every class except Halter & Lead Line will get a prize.
